With reference to circular No.10 the date of submission of HAF is extended from 16th April, 2012 to 25th April, 2012. In view of the extended date of submission of HAF, last date of Data Entry, verification, editing & certification for 2012 is also revised and same is enclosed herewith.

In order not to disturb the Haj Action Plan for 2012 the dates of qurrah as finalized in the meeting held on 6th February, 2012 will remain same. All the States/UTs Haj Committees are requested to contact RPOs and assess the likely number of HAF to be received. Deploy extra man power in the last days and ensure that accurate data entry is completed within time. At the same time please also ensure that data entry is completed systematically and avoid mistakes. I hope you will raise up to the new challenging situation and do not offer same old explanation for the age-old data entry mistakes. This office is strictly adhering on the dates of qurrah, therefore, conduct qurrah as per schedule.

Kindly note, that Haj is a time bound task in which all the activities are scheduled in Haj Action Plan approved by Ministry of External Affairs, Government of India. Any delay or mishap will affect the other activities of Action Plan.
