
Sub: Haj-2012. Affidavits.

Haj Committee of India in its ordinary meeting held on 4th July, 2012, decided to cancel seats of reserved category Pilgrims due to deficiencies found in the affidavits. On humanitarian grounds the cancelled Pilgrims are approaching all concerned in this matter. The Haj Committee of India in its meeting held on 22.09.2012 discussed the issue and it is felt that the Affidavit criteria has been introduced for the first time. The Pilgrims were not adequately educated on this new clause by State Haj Committee/UT Haj Committee, which resulted in cancellation of Haj journey of 70+ years Pilgrims and fourth time applicants. Accordingly, the Haj Committee of India decided to reconfirm the cancelled seats of Reserved Category Pilgrims otherwise fulfilling all conditions by giving an opportunity to remove the deficiencies.

You are advised to approach such Pilgrims and ask them to submit revised affidavit indicating all clauses as per affidavit proforma provided in the Guidelines for Haj-2012 so that other necessary action may be taken in this regard subject to the condition that they fulfill other policy guidelines and to submit their passport.

You are requested to thoroughly scrutinize the affidavits (now going to be submitted) at your level to avoid any hardship to the pilgrim before forwarding to the Haj Committee of India.
