1. Online application processing fees through e-payment Credit/Debit Card, Net Banking and UPI.
2. Non-refundable processing Fee of Rs.100/- is to be paid by each Applicant.
3. Please upload **Recent** Passport size Photo of Applicant (Size: 2.00x2.5 inches).
4. Please upload the copy of Applicant signature (Size: 2.00x2.5 inches).
5. Please upload Essential Qualification Certificates, Caste Certificate and Income Certificate (maximum size 500kb JPG).

Eligibility Criteria.

6. **Essential Qualification:** A Graduate/Final Year appeared from recognized University / Institute in any subject at the time of filling application form. It is mandatory to submit Graduate/Final Year self-attested Mark Sheet/Certificate at the time of admission else his/her application will be treated as cancelled.

7 The age of the candidate should not be less than 21 years and maximum age should not be more than 30 years as on 1st August-2025.

8 **Selection process for XV batch for the academic Year 2025-26:**

There will be (2) Paper tests Two hour duration each.

(a) **Paper –I: General Studies-** There will be Written Entrance Test of Multiple Choice Question (MCQ), having **100 Questions** from different subjects, pertaining to UPSC Prelims Examination i.e. History, Geography, Polity, Economics, Science-Technology/Environment, Arts & Culture, Current Affairs & CSAT, for 200 Marks. Each Question carries 02 marks, with **negative marks of 0.66 for each wrong answer.**

(b) **Paper-II: CSAT-** Comprehension, logical basis numeracy having **80 Question** for 200 marks each question carries 2.5 marks with **negative marks 0.83 for each wrong answer.**

Note: Paper-2 will be qualifying paper with the minimum marks fixed 30% merit list will be prepared on the basis marks of Paper-1. Shortlisted candidates as per Merit List will be called for Essay Writing & Personal Interview.

(c) Selected candidates **Security Deposit of Rs.15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand Only) Refundable** will have to be paid at the time of Admission. Once the Candidate is admitted in Haj House, he/she will not be allowed to leave before Preliminary Examination to be conducted during May, 2026, else his/her deposit will be forfeited.

(d) Refund of Security Deposit will only be made after Preliminary Examination.

9 The entrance test includes a written test based on the syllabus prescribed by UPSC. The test will be held simultaneously at **Twenty One (21)** centers namely **Ahmedabad, Bengaluru, Chennai, Delhi, Chandigarh, Jaipur, Roorkee, Guwahati, Hyderabad, Kolkata, Mumbai, Patna, Ranchi, Raipur, Srinagar, Jammu, Calicut, Lucknow, Prayagraj, Aligarh and Bhopal.**
