- 2. A Mock Test will be available on 27.11.2025 from 10:00 AM to 05:00 PM, which candidates must attempt during this period at their convenience.
- 3. The CBT and the Mock Test shall be conducted online in a Human-Proctored mode. Candidates may appear for the test from any suitable location—such as their home or office—using a camera-enabled desktop, laptop, or mobile device. Detailed system requirements, test URL and instructions are available at Annexure-I.
- 4. The login credentials for both the Mock Test and the Computer-Based Test (CBT), along with instructions, will be sent individually to all eligible candidates via email at least one day prior to the test. A brief SMS notification will also be issued.

- 4. Use latest Google Chrome only (update via Play Store)
- 5. Turn off all notifications and incoming calls to avoid automatic exam termination.

# Important Instructions (Before and During the Test)

- 1. Sit in a disturbance-free, quiet, well-lit environment, no other person should be around.
- 2. Login using the User ID and Password provided via Email/SMS.
- 3. No books, notes, or additional devices are allowed.
- 4. Earphones / Headphones / Airpods are strictly prohibited.
- 5. Your microphone and webcam will remain active throughout the exam.
- 6. Do not switch windows / tabs doing so may cause automatic termination.
- 7. The Proctor (Invigilator) may contact you during the exam for verification.
- 8. In case of temporary internet issues, wait and resume.
- 9. The exam will start exactly at the scheduled time; login early.
- 10. The test shall carry 150 marks with 50 multiple choice questions of two types: (a) 25 fact-based; and (b) 25 situation/case scenario-based.
  - Fact-based questions shall carry 50 marks, each having one right and three wrong choices, right choice carrying 2 marks and wrong choices having zero marks. No question shall have negative mark.
  - Situation/case scenario-based questions shall carry 100 marks. Each question shall have four choices, each carrying 1-4 marks based on appropriateness to the situation. The best choice shall carry 4 marks and the least preferred choice shall carry 1 mark. No question in this category shall have zero or negative mark.
- 11. The questions shall be available in both English and Hindi. Candidates may attempt the test in either language and may switch between the two during the examination.
- 12. Candidates may navigate between questions freely and attempt them in any order during the exam.
- 13. Any form of malpractice or failure to comply with proctor's instructions will result in disqualification and termination of the test.
