NOTICE

Subject: Clarifications to the queries raised on HGO policy for Haj 2027 – regarding.

The Ministry issued the HGO Policy 2027 vide this Division's Notice of even No. dated 03.07.2026, inviting applications for registration of Haj Group Organisers (CHGOs) and allocation of quota for Haj-2027.

2. Various representations have been received from associations of HGO applicants / individual HGO applicants seeking various clarifications w.r.t. HGO Policy for Haj-2027.

The issues flagged by the HGO applicants or their associations, have been examined by the Ministry and the Ministry's clarifications/instructions/amendments on the HGO Policy for Haj-2027 as approved by the competent authority are as under:

Clarifications to the Queries Raised on HGO Policy for Haj 2027

i. Point 2 of Notice dated 03.07.2026 of HGO Policy for Haj 2027:

It is hereby clarified that only Application Fees (non-refundable) amounting to INR 20000 would be required to be submitted at the stage of initial application by individual HGO applicants. However, Security Deposits as specified in the HGO Policy-2027 would be required to be submitted only by the eligible individual HGO applicants along with their CHGO applications during Stage-2.

If the eligible HGO applicants have already deposited FDRs / BGs with the Ministry, they are permitted to submit them as Security Deposit for the purposes of this policy, subject to submission of extension certificate for the FDR / BG, from the concerned Bank, with validity upto 31.12.2027.

In case of change of category, requiring higher Security Deposit, additional FDR(s) equivalent to the enhanced security deposit requirement shall also be submitted by the applicant with validity upto 31.12.2027.

ii. Clause 3.6, Page No. 4, HGO Policy for Haj-2027: For determining turnover eligibility, financials of the preceding financial years are to be submitted by HGO applicants of all categories. HGO applicants of all categories may, in lieu of any financial year in which Haj was not conducted or the Haj quota was curtailed,

submit the audited financial statements of the immediately preceding financial year(s). It is clarified as under:

"For Haj-2027, on account of non-conduct of Haj or curtailment of Haj quota, the applicant may submit the audited financial statements of the preceding eligible financial year(s) i.e. FY 2019-20; 2023-24 and 2024-25, along with the corresponding supporting Haj documents".

iii. Point 11 of Annexure-I, Page No. 12 of HGO Policy for Haj 2027: For submission of Tasreeh / Permit and copies of accommodation receipt together with English translations, the following is clarified:

"The Ministry will consider documents downloaded from e-haj portal / Nusuk Portal submitted in compliance with Clause-11 of Annexure-I to HGO Policy for Haj-2027."

iv. Point 12 of Annexure-I, Page No. 12 of HGO Policy for Haj 2027: Regarding submission of munazzam card by the HGO applicants, the following is clarified:

"Munazzam Card and relevant Haj Visa Pages for all years of claimed experience of the CHGO/HGO, as applicable, may be submitted."

v. Clause 3.5, Page No. 4, HGO Policy for Haj-2027: As clarified earlier vide this Ministry's Notice dated 04.10.2024, it is hereby reiterated that in case Show Cause Notices (SCNs) issued by the Ministry have been responded to by the HGO applicant and no further decision/examination of the Ministry has been communicated to the HGO applicant in this regard, such HGO applicants shall be considered for Haj-2027.

vi. Annexure-I, Point 8, Page No. 12, HGO Policy for Haj-2027: As clarified earlier vide this Ministry's Notice dated 04.10.2024, it is hereby reiterated that these documents are not sought during the normal application process and are sought only in case of complaints/court cases or in case of doubt.

4. It is further clarified that the Ministry may seek any document(s), records or supporting evidence, as deemed necessary, in cases involving court proceedings, or wherever any doubt arises regarding the authenticity, correctness or completeness of the information/documents submitted by the applicant.

5. Further, the last date for submission of individual online applications is hereby extended to **20.07.2026 (1700 hours)**. The printed copy of the online application acknowledgement, along with the physical copy of the application fee payment receipt, shall be submitted on or before **23.07.2026 by 1700 hours**.
