CIRCULAR

Subject: Extension of Last Date for Medical Screening and Uploading of Relevant Documents for Haj 2027

In continuation of Circular No. 10 dated 01.09.2026 regarding Medical Screening and Uploading of Relevant Documents for Haj 2027, it is hereby informed that the last date for completion of Primary Medical Screening (Stage-I) and submission/uploading of the prescribed documents by the provisionally selected pilgrims is **extended from 15.09.2026 to 30.09.2026**.

2. All provisionally selected pilgrims who have not yet completed the prescribed Stage-I medical screening are advised to undergo the same at a government healthcare facility by a **Government Allopathic Medical Officer, along with the prescribed diagnostic investigations** within the extended period and obtain the fitness certificate in the prescribed **Primary Medical Screening and Fitness Certificate Proforma**, as enclosed with Circular No. 10 dated 01.09.2026.

3. NRI pilgrims may, however, undergo the medical screening in their country of current residence **preferably through a government health facility**.

4. Following the medical screening, the pilgrims should upload the following documents on the HCOI portal or submit physical copies to their respective State/UT Haj Committees on or before **01.10.2026**:

- a. Primary Medical Screening and Fitness Certificate;
- b. Copy of Pay-in-Slip/online payment receipt.

5. The pilgrims are advised to keep the **original Medical Screening and Fitness Certificate and all investigation reports in safe custody**, as the same shall be required to be produced before the medical team at the time of **Stage-II medical screening and vaccination**.

6. It may be noted that the candidature of a pilgrim found medically unfit, as per the prescribed fitness criteria, shall be cancelled and the amount deposited by the pilgrim shall be refunded as per the applicable provisions. However, any pilgrim found to have **concealed or furnished false information regarding his/her health or medical condition** shall be liable for action, including **forfeiture of the deposited amount and prosecution**, as per the extant policy.

7. The State/UT Haj Committees are requested to coordinate with all the concerned and complete the process in a time-bound manner. They shall also liaise with Government healthcare facilities, maintain proper records of the screening process and promptly report cases of medically unfit pilgrims to the Haj Committee of India.
