### Sub: Quota for Haj – 2022. Regarding.

As conveyed by the Ministry of Minority Affairs US (Haj Division), Government of India, via email dated 28<sup>th</sup> April 2022 in reply to letter HC-13/170/2020/1562 from Haj Committee of India and as per Annual Bilateral Haj Agreement for Haj 2022 between India and Saudi Arabia for the year 1443 (H) 2022, a quota of 56,601 seats for Haj Committee of India has been allocated. The quota allocated to Haj Committee of India has been distributed as per the provision of Haj Policy 2018-22 for pilgrims among various States//U.T. Haj Committees, as per the following details:-

The list of selected pilgrims may be published in local newspapers and electronic media (e-mail/ sms /calls/etc.) immediately after the Qurrah.
  4. It is advised that owing to paucity of time the Qurrah may be held as early as possible preferably before Eid Ul Fitr.
